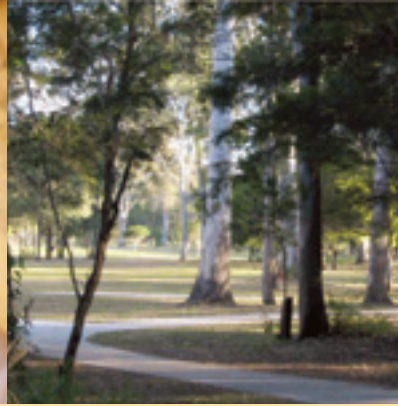

Q. When can I use this offer?
