

Draft Gallipoli Park Masterplan

The Draft Gallipoli Park Masterplan, which has been developed as part of the Urban Design Framework for Marysville and Triangle, will be now out for public consultation from 12 November to 9 December 2009.

The proposed Masterplan will guide works to restore and improve Gallipoli Park following the bushfires. It proposes landscape improvements, as well as identifying locations for community projects, such as the 'Kin Playspace', a skate park and a new life sculpture and gardens.

The Masterplan aims to retain and enhance the established qualities of Gallipoli Park rather than make significant change. It also aims to better integrate Gallipoli Park with other rebuilding proposals for Marysville including the new Community Learning, Health and Recreation Hub, the Marysville 'Heart' project, and the restoration of Murchison Street.

The Gallipoli Park Masterplan is a joint initiative of the Gallipoli Park Recreation Reserve Committee of Management, local community groups, Murrindindi Shire Council (MSC), and the Victorian Bushfire Reconstruction and Recovery Authority (VBRRA).

Marysville residents and other interested people are invited to have their say on the draft Gallipoli Park Masterplan.
