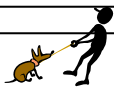
From resident to Village Manager - I have truly enjoyed the opportunity to work with you all to further improve Village Life and continue our journey of recovery home, and recreating our lives anew.

My last day as Manager is December 4th and I will be on call for emergencies over the weekend.

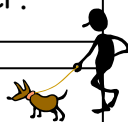
Needless to say I will still be here as a resident, neighbor, friend and party-goer.

Village Gardens - working bee/BBQ



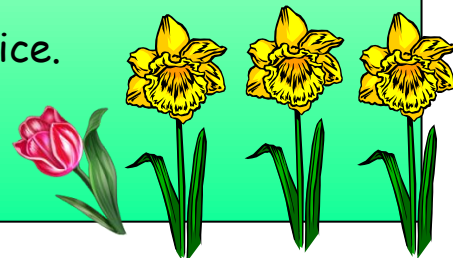
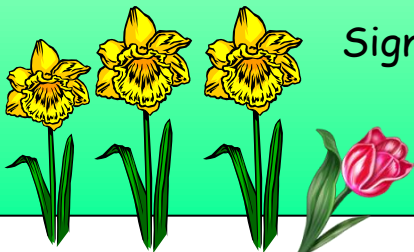
Sunday 6th December - 5-7pm
