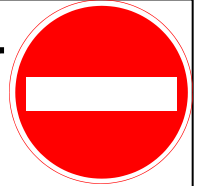

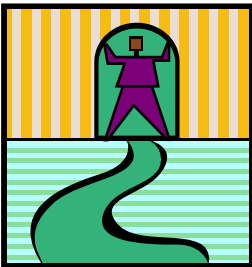

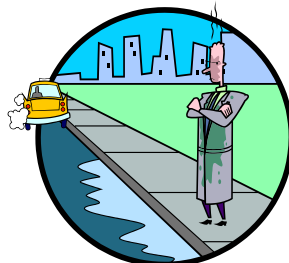
PAVERS

I'm sure there are main residents who remember (probably not so fondly) the red muddy

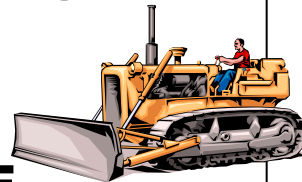
tracks through their units on moving in day.
