Landscaping and civic works to restore key streets of Marysville are being planned.

We'd like to invite you to a workshop at the Marysville Golf Club on the **24th February at 6.00pm.**

Come along and help design the landscaping and civic works to restore Marysville's streetscapes.

Building on the community workshop held in November last year to discuss reinstating the amenity and character of Marysville, you are invited to attend a workshop to help us restore the character of Marysville's streetscapes.

Urban Initiatives, who have previously been involved in improvement works along Murchison Street, has been appointed to undertake the design work.

The Project aims to restore Murchison Street, Darwin Street and sections of Lyell and Sedgwick streets. Works to be considered include:

- **Landscaping and streetscape works to re-establish the public space of Murchison Street;**
- **Retention of trees wherever possible and new street tree planting; and**
- **Strategic civil works in the town centre which may include lighting drainage, waters sensitive design, road works and pedestrian amenity.**

As part of developing the plans, a series of three workshops with the community will be held:

Workshop 1: 24th February 2010

Confirming the vision, opportunities and the options for the 'look and feel' of works.

Workshop 2: mid March

Preliminary designs.

Workshop 3: late March

Draft plans presented for community and stakeholder feedback.

Implementation of the works will be commenced upon completion of the design work subject to funding sources.
