## Community Learning, Health and Recreation Hub: Stage two proposed design



The Marysville and Triangle communities now have the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed design of **Stage Two of the Marysville Community Hub**.

Stage Two is proposed to include a multi-purpose community centre, indoor recreation centre, and community health service and local doctor.

**Multi-Purpose Community Meeting Space** – At street level, there will be a multi-use community space with kitchen facilities, opening out on to a balcony which will have views over the oval. The space will be designed so it can be divided and adapted for different uses. Storage space will be included.

**Indoor Recreation Centre** – At the lower park level, the proposal is for a flexible space for recreation activities, events and indoor sports. It will include retractable seating and a large roller door opening out on to the oval. Adjoining the recreation centre will be club rooms, change rooms, and toilet and shower facilities.

**Community Health Service and Local Doctor** – This is proposed to include treatment rooms for the local doctor and consulting rooms for community health services.

**Stage One Update** – Work on Stage One of the Hub, which includes a new primary school, early learning centre and maternal and child health care centre, is well underway and is due for completion in April 2010.

**A community consultation and feedback period on the Stage Two plans will run from 15 February to 5 March, 2010. Some preliminary consultation with key user groups has already taken place.**
