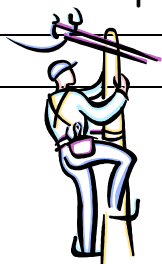
Is your family and household prepared - what was your usual readiness routine?

Are your storages and house mice-proof? And leak-proof?

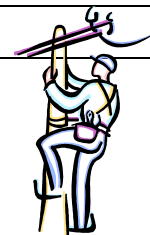

## POWER INTERRUPTION

**March 17<sup>th</sup> – 1pm – 5pm**



The power didn't go off on Wednesday . . . . . Works were delayed due to major power problems elsewhere in the state and have been rescheduled for this coming Wednesday. Much of the preliminary work has been done and this will mean the power outage will be greatly reduced.

Electricians will be in the Village next Wednesday to connect the large generator into the village power network. To do this they will require time to make all of the safe connections and adjustments.

This will require the Village to be without power for a reasonable portion of the day. I have had assurances that they will keep power interruptions to a minimum. Works will be postponed if the weather is inclement (wet & rainy).

Please remember some of our residents live near the laundry and we'd like to make sure they have a quiet restful sleep as well.

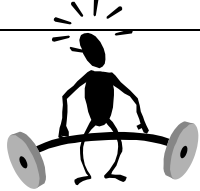

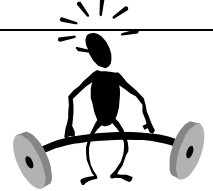

## GYM - COMING SOON.



On Monday March 15<sup>th</sup> a small gym will be installed into the Chapel building. YMCA Eltham have been supportive of this endeavour since October 2009.

John and his team will install the equipment of Monday and 2 induction sessions have been organized for the 18<sup>th</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of March.

Each session will run for approx 15mins to assist you with understanding how to use each piece of equipment safely and effectively as well as giving you a chance to ask questions.

Gym use will be available to all of Marysville and district residents and will require each use to participate in an induction session and sign a waiver form.

If you would like to book for an induction session please let Sue know during business hours. Sessions will run every 15 mins as follows:

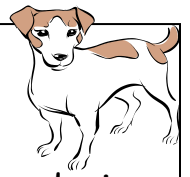
Thursday - March 18<sup>th</sup> – 5:30pm – 7:30pm.

# Wandering Dogs



A number of residents have spoken to me in the last week about dogs wandering around the Village. This has been distressing for both young and old alike. It is noted that the bars on the dog yard gates are quite flexible and a number of dogs are doing a 'houdini' escape through the gates. This can be eliminated by attaching a piece of trellis, shade cloth, colourbond or chicken wire on the gate. If your dog is a bit of a barker - attach something that blocks their vision so they no longer feel the need to bark at everything that moves. To say the very least - it's just not fair nor safe to be confronted with a unsupervised dog of any size. Nor is it fair or acceptable for non dog owners to have to deal with dog poo on their doorstep. How would you feel if neighbours regularly left garbage at your door or on your path? Together we can rebuild, together we will recovery, and together we can continue to make our time in the Village a happy and positive experience for all. So come on do your bit, always supervise your dog, pick up after them and bin it.
