Landcare Fire Recovery Project – Fences Without Boundaries

‘Fences Without Boundaries’ is a fire recovery project coordinated by the Upper Goulburn Landcare Network (UGLN) and the Benalla Uniting Church. Using teams of enthusiastic volunteers from corporate business, including the National Australia Bank and CPA Australia, the Landcare Network has been able to remove and rebuild many kilometres of burnt and damaged fences in the Marysville, Buxton and Narbethong area.

Volunteers have been removing trailer loads of wire, star pickets and posts from properties affected by the Black Saturday fires and under the supervision of Alan Stafford from the Benalla Uniting Church are able to rebuild fences with landowner supplied materials.

Usually office bound, the volunteers have been enjoying the outdoor work and the opportunity to help with the fire recovery in a very practical way.
