



The Murrindindi Toy Library is seeking volunteers! Much has been achieved since its incorporation in November, including receiving significant funding from Rotary and The Helen Mcpherson Smith Trust, details of which can be found on our website. However, the funding does not resolve our need for volunteers to drive the trailers from town to town, and to assist with the borrowing and returning of toys. We also need volunteers to do other administrative roles (newsletter, website, roster coordinator, trailer manager etc), many of which can be done from home. We are hoping that by spreading the tasks over many, it does not become such a burden on just a few!

The committee believes there is a great opportunity for retired/semi retired people to contribute to their community by volunteering, and they hope that the mixing of the generations will benefit both the older generation and the young parents. With the passing of ideas, values and viewpoints, helping the generations interact together could foster a better understanding between them, and certainly foster community spirit which transcends the usual generation gap.

The most vital position we need assistance with at the moment is for people to tow the trailers between the towns. **Please note that petrol is reimbursed at a rate of 20c per kilometre.** Session and trailer towing timetables can be found on our website.
