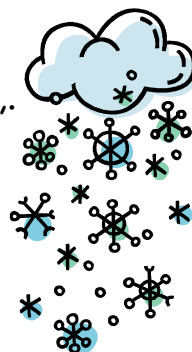


Village Goings on.
