Funding for the “Green Connections” project in the Marysville & Triangle area has been approved, in principle, by VBAF based on support and recommendations from the CRC and wider stakeholders.

	Narbethong Public Reserve	Support for the development of the Narbethong Public Reserve project based on the current Masterplan of the site
	Triangle Roadside Flowers Project	To date, the community has created 30 of 96 clay plaques depicting roadside flowers. The project is to complete the clay plaques, strategically place them around walking trails and points of interest then create a brochure and iPhone application for users to experience the trail. It will make an interesting and educational experience on walking trails and will build awareness of local indigenous flora
