



# Murrindindi Projects Getting Underway

Bovis Lend Lease has been appointed by the Victorian Bushfire Reconstruction and Recovery Authority (VBRRRA) and Murrindindi Shire Council to oversee a two-year program to rebuild community and council infrastructure.

The following projects are the first batch to be built under this program and will get underway in the coming months:

**Marysville Community Centre Stage 2** - construction of multi-purpose centre, community health service and indoor recreation centre.

**Gallipoli Park restoration** - including new Kin Playspace, new life sculpture and Murchison Street garden.

**Narbethong Hall** - construction of a new hall to replace the one burnt down in the February fires.

**Murchison Street redevelopment** - including landscape works, public art, street furniture and the creation of pedestrian friendly links.

**Murchison Street drainage** - additional drainage works to minimise the risk of flooding and provide the infrastructure needed to support the rebuilding of Marysville's commercial centre.

Rebuilding works will be undertaken by sub-contractors under the management of Bovis Lend Lease.

In order to tender for work on these and other upcoming projects in Murrindindi, contractors and tradespeople need to submit a Registration of Interest via Regional Industry Link at [www.regionalindustrylink.com.au](http://www.regionalindustrylink.com.au).

You may then be invited by Bovis Lend Lease to take part in a pre-qualification process, which will involve submitting information on capacity, licensing, previous performance, quality processes and safety.

Responses will be used to establish a panel of pre-qualified businesses which Bovis Lend Lease will target for formal tendering processes.
