Last November Cheryl Laurie from the Culture and Context arm of the Uniting Church gave us all an opportunity to contribute to a 'Waiting Space' sculpture/art piece to be installed at the Village. Many of you will remember the little cards with the words "Waiting for . . ." and "Grateful for . . ." written on them for each of us to finish off. After our contributions were sent in Cheryl and her team went to work to create a series of pavers to reflect our path of 'waiting'; the team also went to work on a large ceramic bowl to express the things we are 'grateful' for.

Today Cheryl and Michael delivered the completed piece which will be assembled as a singular art piece within the Village. We are now seeking input from residents on a suitable space for the sculpture to be installed.

If you would like to view the art pieces they are on display in the Meeting Room of the AUSCO building.

When completed - the pavers will become a small paved area around a red gum sleeper plinth with the 'gratitude' bowl sitting on top.

Cost for keeping your child safe Priceless.

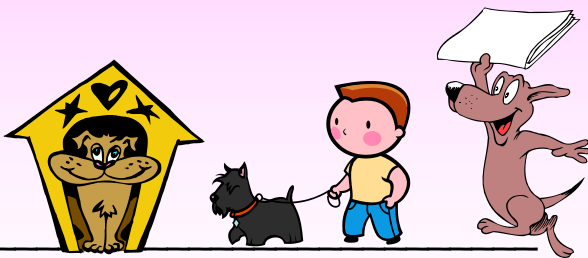


Dog Yard Dilemmas
