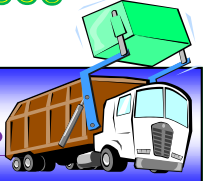

Garbage Bins:

Recently we have had a few problems with garbage bins. Personally I don't think it was the garbage bins fault - however we still need to take care and keep them in good nick if they're to go the distance and do the job we want them to do.

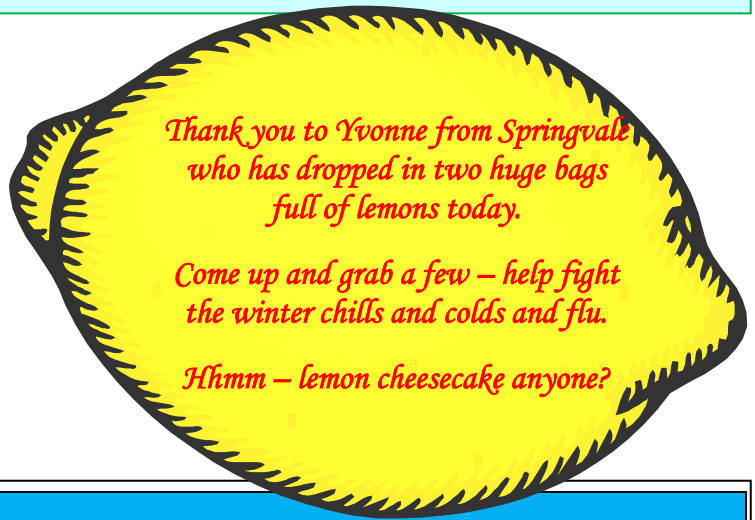
As Mad Dog Way is our only pick up point in the Village - this makes it very congested on a Sunday and Monday.

Here are a few helpful reminders for garbage night:

- * Never block any roadways connecting off Mad Dog Way - this includes Rosella Way, Kookaburra Way, Matty's Mountain and opposite Village Way. This is most important that residents always have access to their streets and driveways, and even more urgent that we keep access open for Emergency Service vehicles. (Bins don't need to be right on the roadway as the Garbos have the facility for accessing bins on nature strips and verges.)
- * Should you have an overflow of rubbish, other options include placing any excess in communal bins at the top of the Village, negotiating with your neighbours or taking a trip to the Tip in Sands Rd.
- * To avoid unpleasant odours from you indoor bins - place all food scraps in a zip lock bag or wrap in newspaper and place in your freezer. Pull out on Sunday night, pop in the bin - viola - no smell, no mess, no worries.

Just a little reminder that garden taps are located on approximately every 4-5 house - so if you are in need of water and you don't have a tap - chances are there's one not too far away. Thanks for sharing the load.



POLICE NEWS:

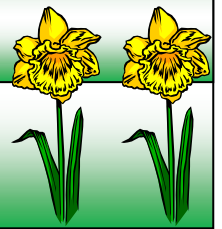
Police would like to remind all parents to ensure their children are wearing bicycle helmets when riding their bikes in a public place.
