

Marysville and Triangle Heritage Trail Update

Marysville and Triangle Development Group (MATDG) were successful in obtaining funding for 2 additional signs to complete the heritage trail project. Thus funding has come from CRC/Council. It will enable the sign for the early history to include the indigenous history. This is very good news as "best practice" dictates it is important to acknowledge the earliest settlers of the area. The second sign is to outline the history of Marysville as a "timber" town. Thanks to Kerrie Bantick in particular and to the Historical society for the photos and information recently obtained to assist with the content development. The information on these signs will go back to the advisory group to be accepted.

Due to the additional work there will be a change to the project timelines as the additional signs will be written then produced together with the others that had been signed off by the advisory group. The final signs will be

- Early history (indigenous/Bartons history).
- Keppels Hotel
- Cumberland
- Mary Chain- sited at Marylands
- Log Cabin
- Crossways
- Kooringa
- Buxton
- Taggerty
- Narbethong
- Timber history
- Rendevous (funded by the Ross family)

Production will commence once the content is all completed. Siting is currently being finalised with the Council, land owners and the various Progress groups. The next meeting of the Advisory group is proposed for 30th July by which time we hope to have the content for the final 2 signs for discussion.
