VBBRA, Hub Captain, Centrelink:	<p>Ray:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only 4 hubs left around the bushfire affected areas. • There has been a new appointment of a Hubs manager – her name is Lisa Hemmer. She has not been involved in Hubs but has been involved in Case Management. Robert is now handing over his knowledge the new manager. • Hub captains have been invited to contribute to a procedures manual, A legacy person will be visiting the hubs. Initial learning has been: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hub captains had an induction of 6 hours – should be a 6 week induction for what they have learnt in the process. • Marysville was the only place that had the hub attached to the village – and it has had a perception that is part of the village – should not happen again should be separate from the village • Not reactive to a disaster – and move the services around rural areas for everyday normal circumstances need. • Learning’s and teachings going forward – they understand that there is a community based group or committee that commences the steps to move forward. • This will happen again in some stage – remote rural areas surrounded by bush, the chair of the recovery body should be in the affected area, not in inner city – people who have been employed have been seconded from govt & big business – it has limited their accountability for their role in the recovery, as they then go back to the job they had before. • Ray will keep this committee up to date • Red cross – Stage 2 of outreach door knock – over the weekend they will starting on outer areas and the village – Ray will then deal with the referrals. • There will be a re-visit of the ATO, and centre link sitting side by side • Telstra will be coming again – try to get that all the day • Hub moving up to the RAC Monday week (26/7/10) • Five towns trail: Report and feedback form will be posted out. Kit left with every home from Red cross door knock. • Hub is still getting approx 60 visits per week. • Marysville is the only hub that has not had a complaint • RP7 meeting – has made a big difference for the group, is going into the VBBRA legacy, • Small business grants – VBBRA say they have listened to the people and they say that they identified the need, however they have not made the paperwork so that it is attainable to the people • Big business proposals need to have the community involved – need to keep community consultation involved - MATDG’s role to keep
